Our website has been up and running for 2 years and all indications are good that that members are starting to use it. Our hopes are that it becomes our main source of communication. We are currently seeking someone to maintain and update the site routinely. See "Website" (pg. 2 for more info). We need more members if we want to accomplish great things for our community. If you have any ideas that may help in doing so please let me know. As you all know the dues are voluntary. Every dollar we collect goes into maintaining the entrances, costs for newsletters, and our website. In order to continue we really need to increase the membership. The recommended dues amount is \$60.00. If you are a current member thank you for caring about your community and its appearance. If you are not a member we urge you to reconsider.

I am also happy to report that Kresson Road entrance finally has water. We will now be able to start our landscaping plan for that entrance. (provided the 2009 membership drive is a success).

It was a group effort between the BCCA, The Bucelli's and the Township Committee spearheaded by Committeeman Harry Platt.

Our long term plan to redesign the entrances has started with the Cooper Road entrance. It was redesigned at the end of 2006 and we are very happy with the change. It is a more natural looking landscape. The lighting was changed to low voltage and up lighting was added. We added perennials and flowing grasses. Beginning this spring we will upgrade the landscaping at the Kresson Road entrance if we collect enough dues. We will also look into upgrading the lighting and obtaining quotes for repainting the Kresson signs. Someday we will be able to have new signs made. I know many, many residents would like to see this happen.

Being President is a somewhat time consuming and usually a thankless job! But it's all worth it when I see our entrances nicely landscaped and colorful throughout the spring, summer and fall. But if anyone is interested in becoming President in the future I'll be happy to ease you in. I've given four and half years and would love to hand it over to someone else but I will continue as long as needed

Now let us talk about some of the issues that have been brought to my attention:

- **Garbage cans stored outside in plain view.** More and more of you have been complaining of the eyesore. Please consider your neighbors when you leave your trash can out. We are working with the Township in solving this problem. We'll keep you updated!
- **Putting out garbage days before pickup.** There are still many of you who consistently put your trash out Monday night or over the weekend. Please be advised that there is an ordinance prohibiting this. If you don't want a fine please obey the rule!

- **Putting out bulk trash weeks before the 3rd Wednesday.** Just recently I noticed a Beagle Club resident who put out a microwave in the street. Since when do we find this acceptable??
- **Property maintenance.** Please remember that there is a **property maintenance ordinance**. To all that keep your property properly maintained, Thank You. For those who may not ... your neighbors would appreciate if you would.
- **If your pup is poopin and you're not scoopin...** Why not???. *It's the law*
- **I ask all of you to be considerate of our landscaping and not walk on it to post signs at the entrance ways or staple notices on the Beagle Club Sign or to the posts that support the sign.** Thank You.

The Township has asked me to remind everyone in the Beagle Club that bulk trash will be picked up on the **3rd FULL WEEK OF EVERY MONTH ON YOUR SCHEDULED TRASH DAY**. The first full week is the week that includes a Monday. Bulk items consist of furniture, mattresses, carpet, excess trash, etc., but not construction and/or remodeling debris. Also during snow removal, the Public Works Department has done a great job in clearing our streets. However, there are still quite a few residents that park their vehicles on the streets preventing complete removal of the snow. Please make it a point to remove all vehicles during snow storms from the streets. Streets that are free from snow accumulation allow emergency vehicles easier access to their destination. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Please note that the local ordinance for putting out trash will be enforced.
